July 2017

It's hard to believe it's the first week of July and the salmon are here. We have had a fairly busy June here at the co-op. Some of the projects that have been accomplished are;

The Tazimina control building has been re-insulated and the high pressure sodium lights have been replaced with LED fixtures. The old roll up garage door in the control building was replaced with a well-insulated garage door. A small building was constructed by the hydro intake for the purpose of installing a large air compressor to run the inflatable dam we intend to install in the river below the intake. The concrete vault that holds the main shut-off valve for the hydro penstock was insulated with 2 inches of blue board Styrofoam and the HPS lights in the vault were replaced with LED wall packs.

The HPS flood lights the light the intake deck were replaced with LED flood lights.

All of this work should significantly reduce the electrical usage of the hydro plant. Big thanks to Steppers Construction for a job well done. We also contracted with ESHCO Construction to drill and blast out about 4 to 5000 yards of rock from upstream of the hydro intake and all along the road in front of the control building to the intake. This work went off with no problems and will help stop rock shedding into our intake and rocks constantly rolling down onto our road to the intake. I would like to extend thanks to Casey Eshleman and his crew for doing a fantastic job with this rock removal.

Don Henry has started the underground power line replacement project. At some point in time we will have a few planned outages for testing and energizing the new power line.

The week of July 17 we are scheduled to replace the riser pole on the Nondalton side of Six Mile Lake. This will require 2 or 3 all day outages for Nondalton. We are hoping to just have the power off during the day and to be able to turn it back on in the evening. I will be reminding everyone a week or so before we start the work.

I hope everyone has a safe July and hopefully all are able to catch enough salmon to fill their smoke houses.

🍯 Blueberry Crumb Bars

Prep Time: 15 m Cook Time: 45m Ready In 1 hour

Ingredients: 1/4 tsp. Salt 1 Cup White (optional) 1 pinch Sugar 1 tsp. Baking Ground Cin-Powder namon 3 cups All 4 cups Fresh Purpose Flour Blueberries 1 cup Shorten-1/2 cup white ing sugar 1 Egg 3 tsp. cornstarch

Directions:

Preheat the oven to 375 degrees. Grease a 9x13 in. pan. In a med. Bowl, stir together

Ic sugar, 3c flour and baking powder. Mix in salt and cinnamon. Use fork or pasty cutter to blend in the shortening and egg. Dough will be crumbly. Pat half of dough into the prepared pan.

In another bowl, stir together the sugar and cornstarch. Gently mix in the blueberries. Sprinkle the blueberry mixture over the crust. Crumble remaining dough over the berry layer.

Bake in preheated oven for 45mins or until top is slightly brown. Cool completely before cutting into squares Interesting <u>Alaska Fact:</u>
