Here at INN Electric I have made a point of trying to make this a community friendly place.

One of the things we offer free as a community service is notarizing services. I would like to clarify what we offer in the way of notarizing and the requirements we have as far as getting your paperwork notarized.

1. Be prepared to present the **ENTIRE** document that is being notarized. If you just present us with a signature page, you will be denied service. A Notary Public **MUST** be able to examine the entire document.
2. Be prepared to present identification. Ayla, Nikki or George know just about everybody BUT if we do not know you personally we will ask for identification. **THAT IS THE LAW.**
3. We reserve the right to refuse service to anybody if we do not understand what it is we are notarizing. **WE ARE NOT LAWYERS** and if we cannot figure out what the document is all about and if it is not clearly labeled where it needs to be notarized, then we will refuse notarization services. If your document needs a lawyer to understand what it is about and where it needs to be signed, then you need to take it to a lawyer to have it notarized.
4. Normally we offer notarization services free. We reserve the right to charge for these services if we are asked to notarize papers after hours and away from our normal work place.

Please remember that we do this as a service to the communities. We welcome everyone who needs notarization services but if we cannot understand what we are notarizing then we will refuse the service.

We are working on a schedule with Geoffrey Park of A Mobile Mechanic to come to Iliamna about every 3 months to work on vehicles. INNEC is providing a shop and a place to stay to help keep the cost down for our consumers. If you have a vehicle that needs mechanical work you are welcome to call the office here to find out when Geoffrey is scheduled out here again. Please remember that Geoffrey does not work for free. If you bring a vehicle for him to work on please be prepared to pay him. Geoffrey does excellent work and we are excited to be able to offer this to our communities and residents as an extra service.

We have received notification from Bristol Bay Native Association that the Alaska Affordable Heating Program (AKAHP) was cut from the State's budget. This program worked in conjunction with the Federal Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) and provided many consumers help in paying their power bills. If you have received energy assistance in the past through the LIHEAP program then there is good chance you will not be receiving the same amount again. It may be substantially less.

Some recipients will not be eligible at all. INNEC has received a list of previous recipients who are no longer eligible. If you would like to know if you are on that list please give us a call at 571-1259 and talk to Nikki or Ayla.

## BLUEBERRY RHUBARB JAM

3 cups rhubarb  
3 cups crushed blueberries  
7 cups sugar



1. Combine ingredients in a large wide stainless steel heavy pot. Bring to a full rolling boil for one minute.
2. Remove from heat. Add 1 bottle Certo pectin (liquid).
3. Stir and remove any foam that rises to the top. Pour into sterilized jelly jars and seal.
