APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP AND ELECTRIC SERVICE USER AGREEMENT

The undersigned (hereinafter called Applicant) hereby applies for membership in INNEC (hereinafter called Cooperative), and the Applicant and Cooperative agree as follows:

- 1. The Applicant will pay to the Cooperative the sum of \$5.00 which, if this application is accepted by the Cooperative, will constitute the Applicant's membership fee. Upon acceptance of this application a certificate of membership will be issued to Applicant; it being understood that this membership is not transferable and fee cannot be applied toward payment of any bill, but shall be refunded upon termination
- 2. The Applicant, by paying a membership fee and becoming a member, assumes no personal liability or responsibility for any debts or liabilities of the Cooperative and it is expressly understood that under the law the Applicant's private property cannot be attached for any such debts or liabilities.
- 3. The Applicant also agrees to deposit with Cooperative such security deposit as is required by Rules and Regulations of Cooperative; it being expressly understood that such deposit shall be non interest bearing and that any portion of said deposit not be applied to the payment of bills due Cooperative shall be refunded to Applicant upon termination of service.
- 4. The Applicant will purchase from the Cooperative all electric energy used on the Applicant's premises and will pay therefor, monthly, the rates which will be fixed by the Board of Directors of the Cooperative.
- 5. The Applicant will cause the Applicant's premises requiring service to be wired in accordance with all applicable codes and regulations.
- 6. The Applicant will comply with and be bound by the provisions of the Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws of the Cooperative and such Rules and Regulations as may, from time to time, be adopted by the Cooperative.
- 7. The Applicant, if a land owner, hereby agrees to grant to the Cooperative, at no charge, the rights and easement to construct, operate, repair and maintain on the Applicant's property, and in or upon all streets, roads or highways abutting said property, its electric distribution and service lines and appliances and also the right to cut or trim trees necessary to keep them clear of all parts of the electric system.
- 8. The Applicant, if a land owner, agrees that all poles, wires and other facilities, including any main service entrance equipment, installed on premises at the Cooperative expense shall remain the property of the Cooperative, removable at the option of the Cooperative upon termination of service to or on said premises.
- 9. The Applicant, if provided a prepaid meter system, will allow the Cooperative access to reasonable times to all components of the prepaid meter system. The prepaid meter system will remain the property of the Cooperative.
- 10. The acceptance of this application by the Cooperative shall constitute an agreement between the Applicant and the Cooperative, and the Cooperative shall provide electric service from the date service is made available by the Cooperative to the Applicant until service is terminated in accordance with the Bylaws and Rules and Regulations of the Cooperative.
