Manager's Report

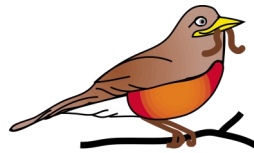
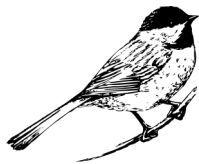
May 2024

Construction season is upon us. As summer starts and things start happening, please don't forget to call INNEC 907-571-1259 for line locates if you are going to be digging. Digging into our underground high voltage primary powerlines is dangerous and VERY expensive. It can also put a lot of people out of power for quite some time if we do not have a lineman readily available. If you are digging and do not call for a line locate, I promise you we will charge you for every penny that it costs us to repair the damages.

Please clean up around your service entrance. I see a lot of meters that are difficult to get to because of junk in the way. We read meters once a month and need easy access to your electric meter. Also, if there is ever a problem with your power and we need to get the meter pulled off, we certainly do not want to be tripping over stuff to get there.

As commercial fishing season get closer, please be sure to get enough credit on your AMPY meter to last for a month or so you are headed to the Bay to go fishing. You certainly do not want to come home to your house having no power and your fridge and freezer all thawed out!!
